- Fourth-largest school district in Illinois (~26,000 pre-K to 12th grade)
- Developed Indian Prairie CARES after a return to in-person instruction in the wake of the COVID-19
- No-cost mental health services are available for all students at these schools and accessible to their feeder schools
- Grant - \$500,000

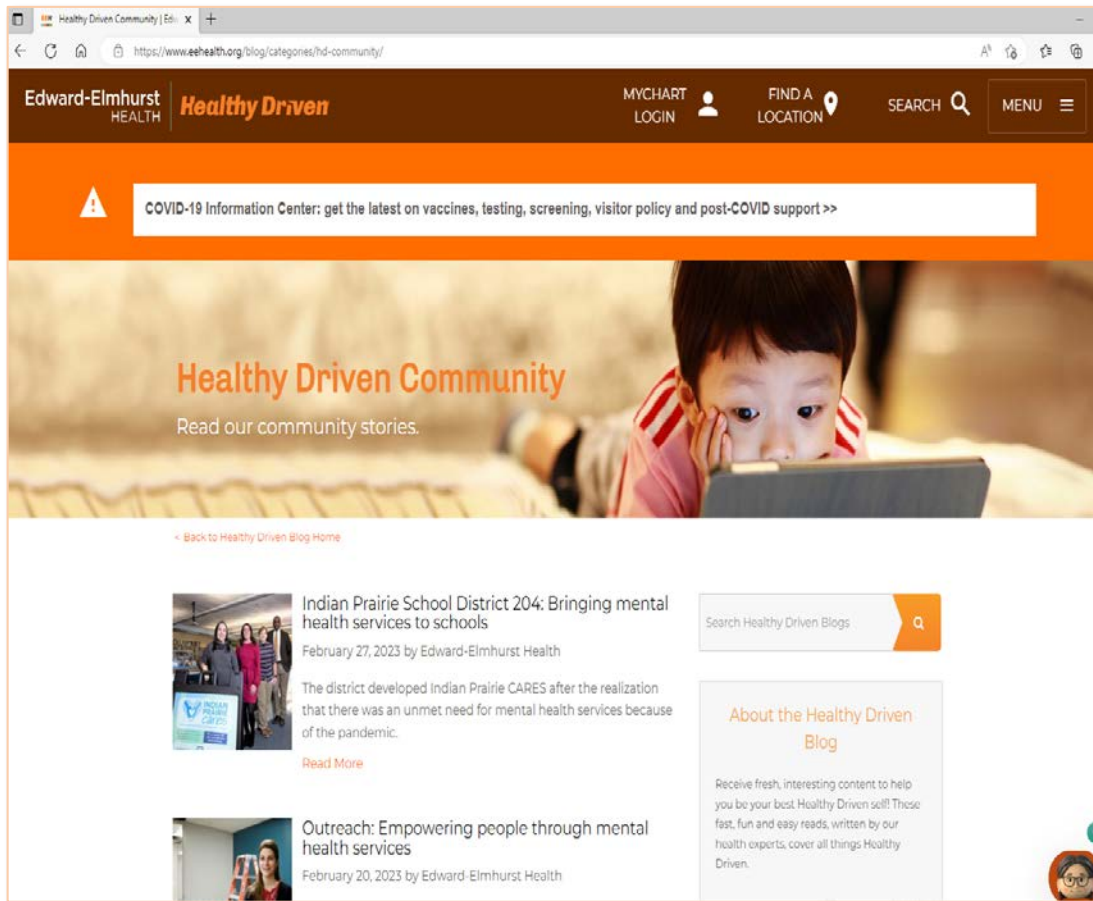
