Tylenol/Acetaminophen Dosing

Please dose every 4 hours as needed. **Do not** give more than 5 doses in any 24-hour period.

- Children's Oral Suspension = 160 mg/5ml
- Children's Chewable = 80 mg
- Jr Strength Chewables= 160 mg
- Regular Strength Caplet = 325 mg
- Extra Strength Caplet = 500 mg

Ibuprofen/Advil/Motrin Dosing

Ibuprofen is dosed every 6-8 hours as needed. **Never give** more than 4 doses in a 24-hour period Please note the difference in the strengths between infant and children's ibuprofen. Do not give ibuprofen to children under 6 months of age unless advised by your doctor.

- Infant Concentrated drops = 50 mg/1.25ml
- Children's suspension = 100 mg/5 ml
- Children's chewable = 100mg
- Ibuprofen tablets = 200mg
